The online submission of application form for IAP-ICC-CET (2019 Admission Session) begins on 24th October 2018 from 11:00 AM onwards. Online applications can be accessed and completed till 05:00 PM on 06th November 2018.

- Exam will be conducted at online only.

#### **5. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR IAP-ICC-CET -2019 JANUARY ADMISSION SESSION**

- Candidates who are in possession of post graduate medical degrees in Pediatrics DCH/MD/DNB ,Provisional Pass Certificates by 31st December 2018 and their medical qualifications are recognized as per the provisions of the Indian Medical Council Act 1956.
- Candidate should possess permanent registration certificate of MBBS qualification and their additional medical qualification should be registered with Medical council of India.

- Candidates found to be ineligible at any stage of IAP-ICC-CET will not be permitted to appear in the examination. In an unlikely event of any ineligible candidate appearing and/or being successful in the IAP-ICC-CET, the results/ candidature of such candidate shall be cancelled and/or are deemed to be cancelled.
- Candidate who are qualifying and getting their results after 31st December 2018 or likely to qualify after 31st December 2018 need not apply in the IAP-ICC-CET exam as they shall be ineligible to participate at any stage of the admission process.
- Registration and /or appearance in IAP-ICC-CET does not confer any automatic rights upon the candidate for admission at IAP-ICC Fellowship accredited hospital / institute.
- Registration with M.C.I./State Medical Council/ is necessary and its documentary proof should be furnished at the time of counseling.

- 20%MCQs simple online answer, 30% Understanding of subject(pathophysiology) 30% Application of Knowledge (case-based decision strategy) 20% Published Guidelines (Case based) 10% Ethical issues and Prevention.
- Allocation of Marks for each MCQ: 1(One)

- No negative Marking

- At the end of online submission of application form, the candidate will get a computer generated acknowledgement at the registered email id of the candidate. Admit card will be issued to the candidate by mail Before 7<sup>th</sup> Nov.2018 5pm.

**7.2 Photograph Upload :**

- Size of photograph: minimum 35x45 mm with at least 75% coverage of face & head of the candidate.
- Background of the Photograph : white
- The photograph needs to be printed on a high quality paper with at least 600 dpi Resolutions.(Maximum Size 1MB)

- Candidate may note that there is no option for submitting the form other than the online mode.
- Candidates are advised to go through the registration guide at website <http://www.piccindia.com> before proceeding to complete their online submission of application form.
- Once the candidate has completed his/her registration process, there will be no option for re-registration.
- Online submission of application form must be completed by the prescribed cut off date (see "Important Dates" section above). At the end of online
- submission of application form, the candidate will get a computer-generated acknowledgement at the registered email id of the candidate.
- Admit card will be issued to the candidate once testing venue has been allotted to the candidate by IAP-ICC in the city chosen by the candidate during online submission of application form. Candidates are likely to get their admit card on their registered email ID before 7<sup>th</sup> November 2018.

### 9.2 Non-Disclosure Agreement

- The IAP-ICC-CET is a proprietary examination and is conducted by IAP-Intensive Care Chapter. The contents of this exam are confidential, proprietary and are owned by IAP-Intensive care Chapter.
- IAP-ICC explicitly prohibits the candidate from publishing, reproducing or transmitting any or some contents of this exam, in whole or in part, in any form or by any means verbal or written, electronic or mechanical or for any purpose. No content of this exam must be shared with friends, acquaintances or third parties including sharing through online means or via social media.
- Social media includes but not limited to SMS, WhatsApp, Facebook, Twitter, Hangouts, Blogs etc using either one's own account or proxy account(s).
- By registering for and /or appearing in IAP-ICC-CET the candidate explicitly agrees to the above Non-Disclosure Agreement and general terms of use for IAP-ICC-CET as contained in this Information Bulletin, and IAP-ICC-CET website. Violation of any act or breach of the same shall be liable for penal action and cancellation of the candidature at the bare threshold.

### 9.3 Unfair means:

If during, training / examination, a candidate is found indulging in any of the following, he/she shall be deemed to have used unfair means

- Candidate undergoing FELLOWSHIP training if by himself or in connivance with the accredited Institute authorities tries to abstain himself from FELLOWSHIP training or submits false/ forged certificate towards FELLOWSHIP training.
- Maintaining incomplete/incorrect log book, attendance records, training schedule, thesis work etc.
- Submission of FELLOWSHIP training certificate with wrong dates of joining and completion of training.
- Candidate misbehaving or using abusive language with other FELLOWSHIP trainees or patients or staff of accredited institute or with the faculty of the accredited institute.
- Candidate who has resigned from FELLOWSHIP course (after joining the FELLOWSHIP course) if appears for FELLOWSHIP entrance during the scheduled duration of training.
- If a candidate is found to have made a wrong statement in his/her application form for admission to the examinations / counselling /training or has attempted to secure or has secured admission to any of the examinations of IAP-ICC by making a false statement or by production of a false document.
- If at any stage a candidate has tampered with any entry in the certificate or statement of marks or any certificate issued by any governmental or non-governmental body or any other document that has been issued to him/ her by the chapter.
- Use/possession of any kind of electronic gadgets including mobile phones with or without internet (whether the gadgets are used or not).
- Having in possession of any note-book(s) or notes or chits or any other unauthorized material concerning the subject pertaining to the examination paper.

Impersonation.

- Candidate appearing multiple times with same or different identity in different sessions of same examination conducted on Computer Based Testing platform.
- Using or attempting to use any other undesirable method or means in connection with the examination.
- Smuggling out Question Paper or its part; or smuggling out answer book/supplementary answer sheet or part thereof.
- Running away or swallowing or destroying any note or paper or material found with him/her. If the answer books show that a candidate has received or given help to any other candidate through copying.
- Threatening any of the officials connected with the conduct of the examinations or threatening of any of the candidates.
- Disclosing his/her identity or making distinctive mark in the answer book for that purpose or fails to deliver his/her answer book/ continuation sheet before leaving the examination hall.
- Hacking or attempting to hack or causing interference with the website of IAP-ICC or its Technology Partner(s) or their Information Technology systems.
- Tampering with Information Technology systems of IAP-ICC or Technology Partner(s) or Computer Laboratory.

- Any candidate found guilty of having adopted anyone or more of the above Unfair means/misconduct is liable to be penalized with a penalty by the Ethics Committee, which may vary from cancellation of the examination/ expulsion up to next 14 attempts/7 yrs and/or cancellation of candidature as may be decided by Examinations Ethics Committee after considering each case. The above list is purely indicative. If any act of omission or commission attributed to the candidate/intent by the candidate to vitiate the sanctity of the examination in decision of IAP-ICC shall be taken up as unfair means.

**Disclaimer** – The decision of IAP-ICC shall be final and binding for declaration of any person /candidate guilty of foregoing or such offence as shall be classified as Unfair Means Case.

The candidate by indulging in unfair means, may in addition to rendering himself liable to criminal prosecution, be liable: -

- To be disqualified by the IAP-ICC from the Examination for which he is a candidate; and/or
- To be debarred either permanently or for a specified period: - By the IAP-ICC, from any examination or selection held by them; By the Central /State Government from any employment under them; and
- To disciplinary action under the appropriate rules if he is already in service under Government.

## **10. RESULTS**

### **10.1. QUALIFYING CRITERIA**

All candidates appearing in the exam shall be given a merit position based on the marks obtained by them.

### **10.2 VALIDITY OF CET RESULT**

The validity of the result of the IAP-ICC-CET shall be only for the current admission session i.e. January 2019 admission session only and cannot be carried forward for the next session of IAP-ICC CET FELLOWSHIP.

### **10.3 DECLARATION OF RESULT**

The results for IAP-ICC-CET shall be declared by 26th November 2018. The mark sheet-cum-result certificate for the IAP-ICC-CET examination can be downloaded from IAP-ICC website <http://www.piccindia.com> after the declaration of result.

### **10.3 TIE – BREAKER CRITERIA**

- In the event of two or more candidates obtaining the same marks, the merit position shall be determined by the following criteria.
- candidates who fulfil the Minimum eligibility criteria as prescribed in this Information Bulletin and possess Post Graduate Medical qualification certified by any one of the following shall be placed higher in the merit:
  - IAP-Intensive care Chapter India OR
  - Royal Colleges of various disciplines UK OR
  - American Board of various disciplines USA OR
  - Royal Colleges of various disciplines Canada OR
  - Royal Colleges of various disciplines Australia
- Based on the marks obtained in the Post Graduate Exit Examination of eligibility qualification (wherever available).
- If the tie is not resolved by above criteria or marks are not available the merit position shall be determined using the following criteria in descending order:
  - Candidate who has passed all MBBS professional Examinations in First attempt shall be placed at higher merit position.
  - Candidate with higher aggregate marks (in percentage) in all MBBS professional Examinations shall be placed at higher merit position.
  - Candidate with higher aggregate marks (in percentage) in 3rd MBBS professional Examination (Part-I & Part-II) shall be placed at higher merit position.
  - Candidate with higher aggregate marks (in percentage) in 2nd MBBS professional Examination shall be placed at higher merit position.
  - Candidate with higher aggregate marks (in percentage) in 1st MBBS professional Examination shall be placed at higher merit position.
- Failing which, date of birth of the candidate will be taken into consideration. Older candidate will be placed at a better merit position.
- There is no provision for re-checking or re-totalling or re-evaluation of the question paper, answers, marks and no query in this regard will be entertained.

#### **11. CENTRALIZED MERIT BASED COUNSELING- JANUARY- 2019 ADMISSION SESSION**

- **ELIGIBILITY FOR COUNSELING:** Candidates who qualify the Centralized Entrance Test to be conducted by IAP-ICC on 26th November 2018 and fulfil the eligibility criteria for admission to FELLOWSHIP post-doctoral courses (2019 admission session) at various IAP-ICC accredited Institutions in India shall participate in the counselling for allocation of seats on merit cum choice basis.

- Candidate pursuing DM (other than FELLOWSHIP course) can join a FELLOWSHIP seat only after he/she resigns from such course. Seat allotment letter to such a candidate shall be issued by IAP-ICC (within the calendar of admission) only if the candidate has been relieved and discharged from the institution/college/hospital from where he/she is undergoing such post graduate medical course.
- Ineligibility, if detected at any stage, IAP-ICC reserves its rights to take necessary actions as deemed fit including but not limited to cancellation of admission to FELLOWSHIP course and to debar the candidate from taking any further examinations conducted by IAP-ICC.
- Candidates joining FELLOWSHIP for Jan 2019 admission session, after opting a confirmed seat through FELLOWSHIP CET Centralized Counselling shall not be eligible to appear in FELLOWSHIP CET and shall not be eligible for another FELLOWSHIP seat for the entire duration of their FELLOWSHIP Course of One Year. This shall be irrespective of their resignation or discontinuation from the course due to any reason i.e. Jan 2019 session joined candidates shall be debarred from appearing in FELLOWSHIP CET and admissions till December 2020.
- A candidate can also exercise his/her option for participation in further round of counselling (i.e. opting out) through IAP-ICC website <http://www.piccindia.com> till the day of his / her scheduled counselling. The candidate need not appear for counselling in-person at IAP-ICC office Mumbai for opting out for further round of counselling.
- Candidate can access IAP-ICC website from anywhere to use the facility for opting out for further round of counselling. Such candidate shall not be marked as absent and shall be given an opportunity to participate in further round of counselling as and when conducted by IAP-ICC for the same academic session.
- Candidates absent/not participating in any of his scheduled round of counselling either in-person or through online (opt out) shall not be eligible for participation in subsequent round(s) of counselling. i.e. Attending the previous round of counselling in-person or through online mode is essential to make the candidate eligible for the subsequent round of counselling (if any).
- Candidates opting for a confirmed seat are NOT eligible for participation in subsequent round(s) of counselling irrespective of their joining/non-joining/resignation from the seat already opted for.

#### SCHEDULE FOR COUNSELING:

- The schedule of FELLOWSHIP Centralized counselling shall be made available on IAP-ICC website [www.piccindia.com](http://www.piccindia.com)
- Merit list of eligible candidates shall be notified on IAP-ICC website <http://www.piccindia.com>

- Candidates will be able to download their Rank letter for participation from IAP-ICC website <http://www.piccindia.com> after the merit list is notified.
- AVAILABILITY OF SEATS: The indicative seat matrix for FELLOWSHIP seats will be available on IAP-ICC website after 18<sup>th</sup> Nov 2018
- Final Seat matrix shall be displayed at the counselling venue and IAP-ICC website before the commencement of counselling.
- The counselling shall be done purely based on the FELLOWSHIP-CET Merit Position. In the event of two or more candidates obtaining same IAP-ICC-CET marks, the Tie breaker criteria are mentioned under clause 10.3 of this information bulletin.

#### COUNSELING ELIGIBILITY

- 1st Round Candidates who have qualified the FELLOWSHIP-CET conducted by IAP-ICC in the respective session and fulfil the eligibility criteria for admission to the respective courses at various IAP-ICC accredited Institutions /Hospitals in India shall be eligible to participate in the counselling for allocation of seats purely on merit cum choice basis.
- 2nd Round Candidates participated in the 1st Round of counselling either in-person or through online (opt out) shall be eligible for participation in the 2nd round of Counselling in order of merit.
- 3rd Round Candidates participated in the 2nd Round of counselling (if conducted) either in-person or through online (opt out) shall be eligible for participation in the 3rd round of Counselling in order of merit.

#### ALLOTMENT OF SEATS BY PERSONAL APPEARANCE:

- The allotment of seats shall be made to the eligible candidates only through personal appearance and they shall be called in batches in the order of their merit position as per the schedule of Counselling available on IAP-ICC website.
- Candidate must be present in person on the day of his/her counselling to participate in the counselling for opting for a confirmed seat at scheduled time specified in his/her Rank Letter.

Authorized representative on behalf of candidate shall be permitted only after due approval of IAP-ICC in exceptional circumstances only at sole discretion of IAP-ICC.

Courses 2019 admission session shall be adopted, the relevant documents to resolve the tie shall be produced by the candidate at the time of counselling.
- c. MBBS Degree certificate.
- d. FELLOWSHIP, MD/MS Degree certificate/Provisional Pass Certificate\*
- e. Permanent Registration certificate issued by MCI/State Medical Council for registration of MBBS qualification.
- f. Matriculation/High School/Higher Secondary Certificate as a proof of Date of Birth.
- g. Proof of declaration of result of qualifying Post Graduate Medical Qualification (MD/MS/FELLOWSHIP) on or before 31st of December 2018.
- h. Proof of training completion of qualifying Post Graduate Medical Qualification (MD/MS/FELLOWSHIP) on or before 31st of December 2018.
- i. Matriculation/High School/Higher Secondary Certificate as a proof of Date of Birth.
- j. Any document (Bonafide certificate/Mark sheet/Attempt Certificate etc issued by concerned institution/medical college) confirming the name of the institution/medical college from where the MD/MS qualification was pursued.
- k. Any other relevant certificate or document. Candidates are required to bring self-certified photocopies of the documents mentioned at S.No. (b) to (k). Self-Certified photocopies must be submitted to IAP-ICC at the time of documents verification.
- l. Candidates without original documents will not be allowed to appear/ participate in Centralized Counselling by IAP-ICC under any circumstances.
- m. Seat Allotment letter will be issued to the candidate opting for a confirmed seat on the same day of counselling subject to fulfilment of eligibility criteria.
- n. JOINING OF THE COURSE: Each candidate shall be given a prescribed time from the date of issuance of the seat allotment letter to report and join the allotted IAP-ICC accredited Medical college/Institution/Hospital. Joining means deposition of the prescribed fee by the candidate at the accredited hospital/institute and resuming his/her duties as FELLOWSHIP trainee.
- o. Candidate must begin his/her FELLOWSHIP training within the prescribed time only. Candidate is required to submit their joining report to IAP-ICC in the prescribed format.
- p. The allotment made will be firm and final. Change of Institute/college from one place to another is not permitted under any circumstances. Requests for the same shall not be entertained by the IAP-ICC after the allotment of seats.
- q. Joining of a candidate to a IAP-ICC accredited institute through Centralized Merit Based Counselling is subject to medical fitness of the candidate by the hospital/institution.
- r. The medical examination of the candidate shall be done by the Medical Board of the concerned IAP-ICC accredited institute. Candidate found fit in the medical examination shall only be allowed to join the FELLOWSHIP course.

- s. All disputes pertaining to conduct of COUNSELING by the IAP-ICC and allocation of seats in various specialties and colleges/institutions by the IAP-ICC shall be within the exclusive jurisdiction of competent courts at **Mumbai** only.

#### PROCEDURE FOR REGISTRATION WITH IAP-ICC FOR FELLOWSHIP COURSE:

- Candidates are required to furnish following documents to IAP-ICC within one month of joining FELLOWSHIP training to get registered for FELLOWSHIP course:
- A duly completed application form for 2019 admission session.
- A registration fee of Rs. 20000/- is to be deposited through online payment at chapter website <http://www.piccindia.com> . Transection copy of this challan needs to be enclosed with the registration form.
- Registration letter can be downloaded from IAP-ICC website once the registration process is completed.
- In an unlikely event of an ineligible candidate getting admission to FELLOWSHIP course, IAP-ICC reserves its right to revoke his/her admission from FELLOWSHIP course.

#### 13. (PROVISIONAL) AVAILABILITY OF SEATS FOR 2019 ADMISSION SESSION

- The indicative seat matrix for FELLOWSHIP seats will be available on IAP-ICC website after 18<sup>th</sup> Nov 2018
- The availability of seats varies based on decision of IAP-ICC and response of participating hospitals /institutions.
- It is mandatory that of all FELLOWSHIP seats at IAP-ICC accredited hospitals institutions shall to be filled through centralized counselling only.
- The final Seat matrix shall be displayed at the counselling venue and at IAP-ICC website before the commencement of counselling.
